A Victorian silver goblet, embossed and chased with fruiting vine, London 1863 by Alexander Macrae, height 17cm, together with a pierced silver oval basket, Sheffield 1898, fitted with a cranberry glass liner, length 13cm, a .800 silver cigarette box, two glass scent bottles, and a French silver mounted blue glazed vase, height 17cm.

Condition Report

471. Silver mounted blue porcelain vase - generally good condition with two dents to the foot. Typical light scratches to glaze.

Blue glass scent bottle - minor chips and wear to gilt.

Silver and blue flash scent bottle - hinge lid badly squashed and damaged. Glass is good.

Goblet - bowl has engraved inscription. Dented and badly worn.

Oval dish - generally good condition. No significant damage or repairs. Glass liner chipped and cracked.

Cigarette box - slight misshaping, surface scratches and wear but ok.
