### LOT 716

An Edwardian 9ct gold bar brooch, the centre applied with a tulip stem within an oval surround, flanked by floral and beaded decoration, Chester 1903, width 4.2cm, cased, a pair of gold, rose cut diamond and sapphire circular earrings with hook shaped fittings, one detailed '15ct', cased, a gilt metal brooch, the swivel centre glazed to each side, and another gilt metal brooch, with a case.

Estimate: £70 - £100

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### Condition Report

716. Gold tulip brooch - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Slight misshaping and missing a single stone which would have been set to right of tulip.

Pair circular earrings - generally good condition if a bit dirty. Typical surface wear and scratches. Converted from originally being studs.

Gilt metal oval brooch - worn and red stone cracked.

Gilt metal and glazed brooch - wear to gilt and minor misshaping to surround, otherwise generally good order.

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
