A pair of Derby porcelain figures of Dresden shepherds, late 18th/early 19th century, modelled as a gallant and his companion, he with a basket of fruit and a dog at his feet, she with an apron of flowers and a lamb at her feet, on pierced scroll moulded bases, red painted factory mark to base of male figure, each incised 'No. 55' and '2', height 19cm, together with another Derby Dresden shepherdess and a Stevenson & Hancock Derby Imari coffee cup and saucer (faults and restoration).

Condition Report

1481. Lady with pink jacket - considerable restoration which has begun to flake, could probably be made to look better.

Lady with blue jacket - broken through neck and restored with other similar breaks and/or restoration to hat brim, both arms and part of yellow apron held in right hand and sheep's left ear. Losses and repairs to bocage.

Gentleman - yellowing and/or peeling restoration to neck, right arm and hat brim. Losses and repairs to bocage. Crazed.
