A pair of Worcester porcelain Hop Trellis pattern saucer dishes, circa 1780, unmarked, diameter 15cm, together with a group of English porcelain and pottery teawares, late 18th/early 19th century, including a Worcester Gold Queens pattern teacup and saucer and a Barr Worcester Queen Charlotte pattern teacup and saucer (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1422. Pair Hop Trellis saucers - one generally ok with light surface wear/scratches, other with small chip and a few tiny nicks to outer rim edge.

Queen Charlotte cup and saucer - light wear/surface scratches, otherwise ok.

Gold cup and saucer - gilded rim of cup worn, saucer with crack and chip.

Cornflower cup - ok, very light wear.

Pottery blue printed tea bowl - restored.

Iron red and gilt cup - gilding rubbed to rim and handles, matching saucer heavily worn and chipped.

Worcester 3 flowers saucer - extensively broken and glued.

5 tea bowls - each with faults.
