An early 20th century plated three-bottle tantalus of rectangular form, raised on a stepped base with ropetwist decorated rims, fitted with three cut glass decanters and stoppers, each with a porcelain decanter label, comprising 'Gin', 'Whisky' and 'Sherry', length 42.2cm.

Condition Report

411. Frame itself is in generally good sound condition with only typical light surface wear and scratches and some typical wear to highpoints of plate. Key works and bar locks into place as it should. All three decanters have chips around the bases and one has a chipped corner which has been filled. Otherwise decanters are generally ok.
