A mid-20th century Ulysse Nardin plated keyless wind open-faced chronometer deck watch, the signed gilt jewelled movement numbered '120594', the signed and numbered enamelled dial with black Roman hours and outer Arabic minutes, blued steel hands and centre seconds and detailed 'Chronometer', case diameter 6.4cm, with cylindrical brass case and glazed screw cover, within a hardwood rectangular hinged box.
