### Condition Report

2004. Good solid frame and fairly sound springing. The padding is a bit soft in the arms and back but not too bad. There is clear wear and stains to the ticking, please note that there is original ticking under the green covers of the seat cushions. Some light scuffs to the legs and very light wear to castors. Depth of seat 66cm, width of seat 134cm.
