A small group of New Hall porcelain, circa 1790-1805, including a slop bowl, two tea bowls and a saucer in the Boy in the Window pattern, No. 425, a Boy and Butterfly teapot and cover, No. 421, and three floral tea bowls, together with a black printed pearlware coffee pot and cover, height 27cm (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1421. Coffee Pot - restoration to rim, handle and end of spout.

Teapot - horizontal crack around lower section of body, crack to base and cover repaired.

Slop bowl - star crack to base, otherwise good.

2 tea bowls - good condition, saucer with chip to rim.

One of the spiral fluted tea bowls and saucers are damaged and repaired. Other tea bowls in good condition with some wear.
