A pair of Worcester porcelain blue scale ground tea bowls, circa 1765-70, painted with gilt edged panels of Kakiemon flowers, open blue crescent marks to bases, diameter 7.5cm, a Worcester blue scale ground soup plate with floral panels, fretted square mark, diameter 25cm, a similar saucer dish, a blue ground Worcester plate, painted with exotic birds, and a pair of Worcester style plates (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1454. Near pair of plates - one sits slightly flatter than the other. Both in good condition with typical light surface wear and scratches.

Soup bowl/dish - few small restored chips to rim, some wear to gilt and scratches to glaze.

2 small dishes - both heavily restored.

2 tea bowls - good condition, one with slight blemish to rim but in the manufacture.
