A late George III mahogany dining table, the top with extra leaf, both ends with tip-top mechanisms, on sabre legs and brass castors, height 72cm, length 264cm, depth 144cm.

Condition Report

2070. Structurally the table is sound, although it is lacking two of the four clips. The top and leaves are a consistent colour, however, it has been stripped back and polished to quite a pale mahogany. The pedestals seem quite solid, however two of the legs on one side have had old professional repairs. The placement of the retaining screws on the underside have been changed at some point but probably just part of an overall restoration. The length with the leaf in is 262cm. The depth is 144cm.
