A creamware cauliflower moulded teapot and cover, circa 1760, the cover and shoulders modelled as florets above overlapping green leaves, unmarked, height 11.5cm (restored).

Condition Report

1405. Typical overall fine crazing to glaze. Spout broken away from body and visibly restored back into position with repainting - including area to side of spout where approx 7cm long fine horizontal haircrack emanates from. End of spout also restored. Cover broken in two to side of finial and visibly restored with repainting. Finial cleanly broken off and re-stuck.
