Three printed and enamelled pearlware tea bowls and saucers, late 18th/early 19th century, each printed in black and coloured in green, yellow, iron red and pink with a farmyard scene of a fox stalking two chickens in a tree within a floral border, unmarked, diameter of saucers 12cm (faults).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

1408. Each piece with typical crazing to the glaze.

Saucers - 2 in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. One with narrow approx 1cm long chip to rim at 6 o'clock and some minor flaking to ochre rim with wishy-washy faded background print.

Teabowls - First with minor chip and tiny nick to footrim and tiny chip to rim interior with light staining to interior. Second missing quite a bit of print to exterior - a manufacturing issue - and light staining to interior. Third OK.
