A Doccia porcelain écuelle and cover, circa 1770-75, the moulded circular body covered in a tin glaze, enamelled with opposing floral bouquets beneath a foliate band, flanked by scroll handles, with gilt outlined detail, the similarly decorated cover with pear finial, unmarked, diameter 12.7cm (small glued chip to rim).

Condition Report

1414. Approx 1.2cm long by 0.8cm wide flat chip to top rim edge exterior, two small pieces of which have been visibly glued back into position. Otherwise both the écuelle and cover in good condition.
