A Meissen porcelain figural candelabrum, mid-19th century, modelled as an elderly gentleman holding a lantern, allegorical of night, standing on a scroll moulded base before a barrel, supporting three floral encrusted scroll arms with foliate moulded sconces, faint mark to base with impressed '45', height 31cm (restored).

## Condition Report

1423. Professional restoration to base underside primarily over a crack running at an angle across the front of one foot, with other areas of professional restoration to base which would seem to be over cracks but there may have been a break possibly. As such the lantern, figures left hand, right leg, small area of barrel behind this leg and the robes here are restored. Crack to scrollwork at back of figure on top of barrel. Both side sconces and drip trays professionally restored and other small areas of professional restoration to scrollwork, flowers and foliage.
