A Meissen porcelain figure Sleeping Louise, modelled after Acier as a woman asleep in a chair, late 19th century, her arm resting on a table, her shoes kicked off and at her feet, raised on a simulated brickwork base, crossed swords in underglaze blue to base with incised 'E.58' and impressed '36' and '56', height 19cm (restored), together with a similar figure in Meissen style, impressed beehive mark to base (some restoration).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

1424. Meissen - foot extended over front edge of base restored. Broken away from base through folds of dress and back of chair legs and professionally restored back into position with some cracks visible to front of dress, consequently missing two horizontal struts of chair and some minor chipping to hair ribbon. Similar example - back of chair restored just above seat with haircrack to back right leg of chair. Right hand restored.
