A pair of Doulton Lambeth stoneware two-handled vases, circa 1873, decorated by Emily E. Stormer, monogrammed, the tapered ovoid bodies with scrolling foliage beneath beaded rims, flanked by similarly decorated handles, impressed and incised marks to bases, height 27cm (minor faults to glaze).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1450. Both vases have some glaze loss to the pale green leaves just above the foot - likely to be a manufacturing issue. Otherwise both in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.
