A 19th century Indian firangi sword with straight fullered blade, blade length 99cm, steel shaped guard and hilt and cord bound grip with cup and spike pommel.

Condition Report

1824. Overall surface rusting which has been cleaned at some time. Point appears re-ground and worn. Blade loose at handle point and chipped along cutting edge. Later grip binding. Pitting and some deeper breakdown in hilt. Slightly misshapen. Old copper repair to handle finial. Loss to point of pommel.
