A Victorian 1821 pattern light cavalry officer's sword by W. Jones & Co, 236 Regent St, London, with single-edged fuller blade with double-edged tip, blade length 89.5cm, engraved with 'VR' cypher, detailed 'The King's Royal Irish 8th Hussars' and monogrammed for Charles Henry Gregg with family crest, triple-bar hilt and wire bound fishskin covered grip (lacking scabbard), with some research paperwork.

### Condition Report

1828. Blade shows evidence of light rusting in the past, although now stable throughout. Handle shows areas of deeper rust and pitting, although again appears stable throughout. Some light surface wear to blade with very slight bend and chip to tip. Some areas of hairlining from recent cleaning attempts. Otherwise, fair condition.
