A Doulton Lambeth stoneware ring tray, early 20th century, surmounted with a nude young girl kneeling on the edge of a rock pool, impressed marks to base, height 11.3cm, together with three further pieces of Doulton Stoneware, comprising an ashtray and match holder, inscribed 'Doulton & Co Ltd, London & Birmingham, Crucible Manufacturers', a jug and a mug (minor faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1530. Ring tray - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Match holder - the central crucible has been broken off from the base and visibly glued back into position with some minor flaking to the orange ground. The crucible itself is not damaged.

Jug - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or repairs. Very light surface scratches.

Mug - two repaired chips and vertical crack to rim meaning silver rim has been misshapen and possibly re-attached.
