A Doulton faience pottery gilt metal mounted table oil lamp, late 19th century, the tapering body decorated with clematis, held within gilt metal supports with scroll detail to the legs, on a cruciform base, the reservoir similarly decorated, fitted with a Hinks Patent burner, total height 41cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1493. The faience of the main body and reservoir are typically crazed but otherwise in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.

The metal reservoir has solder repairs to its seams, otherwise the metal mounts overall are in good condition with only very minor surface degradation.

The burner mechanism seems to be all present and correct - we cannot guarantee this though. There is no chimney or shade.

No signs of conversion.
