A pair of Chinese Fuzhou lacquer vases, probably early 20th century, each shouldered ovoid body and flared neck decorated in gilt with a dragon flanked by a pair of Buddhistic lions, height 37.5cm (some faults).

Condition Report

1156. Vase 1 - chips, cracks and overpainting/repairs to rim. Some visible cracks and repair to footrim. Brown body colour is worn and faded/tired decoration has some wear, but still fairly distinct. Surface scratches.

Vase 2 - chips, cracks and overpainting/repairs to rim. Chips and repairs to footrim. Wear/tired brown body colour. Decoration has some wear, but still fairly distinct. Typical surface scratches.
