A George I walnut lowboy with feather and crossbanded decoration, the moulded top above three drawers, raised on cabriole legs and pad feet, height 74cm, width 92cm, depth 52cm.

Condition Report

2001. The top has some small areas of re-veneering and some minor scuffs and scrapes. There are some sections of the side trims that have been replaced but not really obvious from the top. The front has old but replaced handles and central key escutcheon, the lock looks period. Some patches of re-veneered to frieze and sides, with areas of drying out and some to the bottom edge. Both front legs look ok with only overall surface marks and a minor surface crack to the shoulder. One rear leg has a re-spliced later added foot. The other is missing a shoulder lappet and the other lappet is a later replacement. Otherwise minor scuffs, marks and scratches.
