Condition Report

2007. General appearance and condition is very good with no signs of restoration or repair. Some minor wear to some of the gilt and a few very small chips to a few of the flower cusp feet. No apparent warping to doors. No visible splits or cracks. One replacement ball clip to interior of door. Minor scuffs and bumps. Interior depth for hanging 47cm.

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
