An early 20th century Neoclassical Revival satinwood kidney shape dressing table with moulded gilt rosette decoration, the galleried back above seven drawers, on carved tapering legs, height 92cm, width 137cm, depth 61cm, together with a matching triptych mirror, height 89cm.

Condition Report

2008. General condition and appearance is good with no clear signs of restoration or repair. There is some slight fading and drying out of the rear surface of the dressing table and slight fading to the top but otherwise the polish is original and in good order. The gallery is made to take a piece of glass and there is a shaped glass top fitted. The top edge of the gallery has a slightly splash stained polish, otherwise minor bumps and scuffs. There is a crack to the interior sides of the kneehole, barely visible but relatively substantial.
