LOT 548

A ruby and diamond pendant, the centre designed as a flowerhead, mounted with a cushion shaped ruby within a diamond set surround and an outer openwork surround, mounted with rose cut and cushion cut diamonds, length 6cm.

Estimate: £350 - £450

Condition Report

548. The central ruby is of medium to dark colour saturation and has a few internal inclusions, some of which break the surface of the stone. The diamonds have one or two inclusions, some of which break the surfaces of the stones. There is some variation of cut to the diamonds. There is evidence of a threaded fitting at the back of the piece where a previous brooch pin may have been added. Suggested age - late 19th century.

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
