A white gold, platinum, sapphire and diamond three stone ring, claw set with the oval cut sapphire between two circular cut diamonds, detailed '18 & Pt', ring size approx J, and a 18ct gold, opal and diamond ring, mounted with two oval opals and two pairs of small cushion shaped diamonds, ring size approx J.

Condition Report

561. Sapphire and diamond ring - the sapphire is of medium colour saturation. The sapphire has some surface wear, particularly to the facet edges of the stone. The diamonds slightly draw colour but look to be fairly clear. The ring would benefit from careful professional cleaning. Opal ring - the central opal has probably been replaced in the past. The central opal has a large chip when viewed from the back. All opals have some surface wear. The diamonds have one or two internal inclusions. The date letter of the hallmark has been lost as a result of past sizing. The ring generally a bit worn.
