## LOT 600

An early 20th century gold backed and silver set, opal and diamond pendant in a heart shaped design, mounted with a heart shaped opal within a surround of cushion shaped diamonds, length 3.5cm, with a hinged and detachable suspension loop and a detachable brooch pin for alternative use, with a case.

Estimate: £500 - £700

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## Condition Report

600. Pendant is in generally good clean condition, no cracks or significant damage, but due to the dehydration of the stone there is a light crazing visible under magnification. Opal measure approx: length 29mm x width 22mm x depth 2.5mm.

The opal has an attractive play of colour. There is some dehydration to the opal when viewed from either side. The back of the opal shows some of the associated rock. The diamonds are old cut stones and slightly draw colour and have one or two internal inclusions. The suspension loop is very firmly in place and may not remove for alternative use with the brooch fitting.

Pendant weight 7.3g. Brooch fitting weight 1.9g.

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
