A gold, cabochon ruby and seed pearl set cluster ring, a green agate set Victorian fob seal, engraved with a crest and the initial 'M', a moulded paste and gilt metal rotating fob seal, a gold and glazed hair locket set clasp, a gold, enamelled and glazed hair locket mourning clasp, inscribed and detailed '1808', and a rose cut colourless gem and cabochon red gemstone set cluster ring mount (lacking shank).

Condition Report

619. Ring – the cabochon ruby is of dark colour saturation and shows internal silk under magnification. The seed pearls to the surround are rather dirty. The ring looks reconstructed from a wedding band ring. Initial 'M' seal – circa 1840, the intaglio is in good condition. Rotating fob seal – overall rather worn, the intaglio is filled with sealing wax to some extent. Circular hair locket clasp – in good condition. Mourning clasp – some loss of white enamel to the border, inscription clear, remains of textile to the clasp sides. Cluster – cabochon ruby is of medium colour saturation and numerous internal inclusions, the surrounding rose cut colourless gems do not test as diamonds and are worn to the high points.
