An Egyptian gold, platinum, diamond, ruby and cultured pearl brooch, designed as an exotic fish with a ruby set eye, blowing cultured pearl and diamond bubbles, detailed '18ct&Pt', width 7cm.

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## Condition Report

705. Generally in good clean condition. There is some surface wear to the ruby in particular to the table facet edges. The cultured pearls are slightly dull. The diamonds are eight cut stones and look to be fairly clear. Overall the brooch would benefit from professional cleaning. Suggested age 1940s/50s. Weight 22.8g.

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
