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### Condition Report

719. Cufflinks - slight wear to the lapis lazuli bead terminals of the cufflinks, otherwise in good condition. Fob - the fob seal suspension ring has been strengthened with the addition of an inner ring. The jasper intaglio has very minor surface wear. Circa 1820.
