376. Large tankard - dent to rim and few nicks to rim edge. Otherwise typical light surface scratches. No repairs. Good clear hallmarks. Weight 344g, approx 1 pint. No erasures.
Smaller tankard - good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and couple of tiny shallow dents to body. Good clear hallmarks. Weight 210g, approx half pint. No erasures.
