318. Overall good clean condition with good hallmarks which are only slightly rubbed. Typical light surface scratches and very minor misshaping to foot. No significant damage or repairs, but the front has had an erasure and is slightly thinner in that area, but not obviously noticeable. Weight 432.5g, just under a pint.
