A gold, amethyst intaglio and seed pearl set oval pendant, circa 1910, in a Neoclassical Revival design, the amethyst intaglio carved as a classical bust within an openwork surround, mounted with six seed pearls at intervals, the front with seed pearl set pendant drops, length 6.7cm, on an oval link neckchain with a hook and ring clasp, length 52cm, with a case, and a pair of amethyst and half-pearl set earrings (one gilt metal screw fitting lacking).

Condition Report

805. Pendant ♦ the amethyst is of medium to pale colour saturation and in good condition. The seed pearl surround has an attractive fresh lustre, drops in good condition. Small loop fitted at the back to hold a safety chain. Neckchain ♦ in good condition but is unmarked. Case exterior a little scuffed. Earrings ♦ the one screw fitting is bent at the top. The earrings have circular loop fittings at the backs and are of reconstructed form. Pendant & chain ♦ weight 14g.
