A 19th century French Neoclassical Revival rosewood and parcel gilt console table, the swing frame mirror back with a carved foliate crest and arrow quiver supports, the cushion frieze fitted with a single drawer, on a pair of downswept scrolling supports with carved hound head terminals, on a platform base, height 197cm, width 137cm, depth 65cm (lacking marble top).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

2045. Clearly lacking the top surface which presumably would have been a marble panel. General condition and appearance is quite good having some overall minor chips and wear to the corners and edges of the veneer. The glass has an overall light misting but is ok. The main drawer lining has some woodworm to the sides. The scroll supports both appear to have had some level of repair to cracks just above the hound heads but otherwise general surface wear and marks.
