Generally good condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Few dents to back of case. Hinge is good and closes nice and tightly. A few very minor repairs to enamel at the tips of the edges of the serrated panel. The main panel is otherwise in good condition with nice quality painting and fresh colours. Good clear hallmarks to interior.
