A first pattern Fairbairn Sykes fighting knife with straight double-edged blade, blade length 17.5cm, detailed 'The F-S Fighting Knife, Wilkinson Sword, London', S-shaped nickel plated guard and chequered grip, with nickel mounted brown leather sheath (blade point slightly bent, later alteration to sheath).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1801. The dagger itself has some overall minor surface wear to the handle, with one small dent to the grip. The blade is slightly dented and bent at the tip. The tail piece of the scabbard has been later replaced and there are some scuffs and wear to the rest of the scabbard.
