A Chinese blue and white porcelain kendi, Kangxi period, with later applied white metal collar and cover, the globular body painted with a phoenix amidst peonies, height 16cm (minor chip to spout).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1175. The porcelain body is in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches to glaze. The spout has a small chip to the rim. The neck has a white metal mount which has minor surface wear and some minor dents. The white metal cover is generally in good order but the inner sleeve is slightly misshapen and split.
