A Chinese Ming style blue and white porcelain bottle vase, 18th century, the body painted with a design of lotus flowers and scrolling leafy tendrils beneath a ruyi head collar, the waisted neck with a band of stiff plantain leaves beneath bands of further ruyi heads and scrolls, unmarked, height 36.5cm (restoration to neck and rim).

Estimate: £1,200 - £1,800

Condition Report

1090. Typical minor chips and fritting to the glaze on the rim. The neck and rim have been restored with some overpainting. The bulbous body is in good order with nice crisp painting. The foot is good but it does wobble ever so slightly. The underside of the foot has a firing crack running approx two thirds of the way round but this is in the manufacture.
