### LOT 1120

A small group of Chinese polychrome decorated wares, 17th century and later, including a Straits Peranakan or Baba-Nyonya famille rose kendi, height 22cm (restored), a famille verte jar, 17th century style, painted with phoenixes and peonies, height 13cm, and two famille verte circular boxes and covers, 17th century, diameters 6.8cm and 7cm, together with a bowl and cover, possibly Japanese, height 18.5cm.

### Condition Report

1120. Kendi - main body badly broken and extensively restored with old discoloured restoration and repainting which is beginning to peel and flake.

Jar - two minor nicks to top exterior rim edge, otherwise in good condition.

Floral box and cover - decoration worn, chips and frits to rim edges.

Geometric box and cover - very minor fritting, some wear to decoration. Crazed.

Bowl and cover - bowl badly cracked with chips to exterior rim edge. Cover has extensive chipping to flange and chip to exterior rim edge. Enamels heavily worn overall.
