A pair of Chinese famille verte enamelled biscuit porcelain vases, 20th century, each flattened baluster body with rectangular neck and oval rim, each side moulded in relief with a crane amidst lotus, on a turquoise ground, flanked by a pair of aubergine glazed elephant mask handles, moulded 'China' mark to base, height 22.6cm (both with rim restoration).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1166. Vase 1 - section or rim chipped and repaired with some overpainting. This area is 3.5cm in length and 0.7cm in depth. One corner of foot has been chipped and re-glued, approx 1.5cm x 1.5cm. Otherwise handles and rest of body in good order.

Vase 2 - significant rim damage and repairs and one end of a handle is broken and repaired. Otherwise neck, body and foot in generally good order.
