An early 19th century Indian carved ivory part chess set, Rajasthan, painted and heightened in gilt, modelled as elephants, camels and horses, all with riders, height of king 11.5cm.

Condition Report

2603. Overall paint wear and flaking. The elephant with the canopy has a replaced ear and quite substantial paint wear. The other elephant has lost three finials that should fit on the corners of the howdah. The small green elephant appears to be missing a rider and possibly has replaced ball finials. One of the red horses has a detachable head to the rider. Other minor cracks and small chips with a few head adornments possibly missing. Ten pieces in the Lot, all visible in the main photograph on our website.
