An early 20th century burr walnut 'Grosvenor' range dining room suite by Maurice Adams, comprising a large extending dining table, the curve ended top with three extra leaves, height 75cm, extended length 364cm, depth 136cm, a set of twelve chairs and a sideboard, all raised on cabriole legs.

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

2127. Structurally the condition of the chairs is very good, with no apparent repaired breaks or wobbly joints. One standard chair has a loose top rail joint and one of the carvers has a loose arm joint, but both just need a bit of glue. One standard chair has a small scattering of minor old woodworm at the top of a leg and seat rail. Both of the carvers have been used more than the rest and have more wear to the surface and have been faded due to sunlight. There is one seat pad missing to one of the standards. Overall the surfaces have some minor bumps, scuffs and marks, mainly to lower sections of legs and where the back meets the table edge. Otherwise surface dirt and minor wear.
