Condition Report

803. The leather surface is a much later replacement and there are some areas of repairs to crossbanded edge and stringing. There is a small section of loss to the stringing on left lower edge next to knee-hole. Some minor surface cracks to right side and some overall minor marks and scuffs. Drawer runners and other parts of the understructure have been restored.
