LOT 74

A pair of late Victorian silver mounted decanters and stoppers, each with a twin spiral moulded body with twin spiral moulded neck, fitted with a twin pouring spout, Birmingham 1892 by Hukin & Heath, height 28cm, together with a silver mounted oil and vinegar bottle of conjoined form, with matched stoppers, marks rubbed.

Estimate: £60 - £80

Condition Report

74. Both decanters would benefit from a good clean.

Decanter 1 - good condition, no chips or cracks. Silver in good order with good clear hallmarks. Stopper has typical small chips to terminal and edge of facets.

Decanter 2 - small chip/crack to rim on the inside of the silver collar, only noticeable when looking inside, otherwise glass is in good condition. Silver in good order with good clear hallmarks. Stopper with small chips to terminal and facet edges.

Both decanters with cloudiness to interiors.

Note: both stoppers fit tightly, but as can be seen in the images, the facet balls differ in size slightly.

Vinegar & oil bottle - one neck cracked and stoppers are not original and do not fit. One of the stoppers is broken into two pieces.
