A gold, diamond, half-pearl set and enamelled marquise shaped pendant locket, last quarter of the 19th century, the enamelled centre painted with two cherubs holding a floral garland above clouds within a scroll pierced surround, mounted with half-pearls and rose cut diamonds with a half-pearl and rose cut diamond set suspension loop, the back glazed with a hair locket compartment, length 8cm.

Condition Report

225. The enamel has one or two minor surface marks, the rose diamonds have one or two internal inclusions, the half pearls are of attractive silvery lustre, one pearl has a surface crack. The scrolled surround to the centre enamel is broken in three places and the top section of the border is bent towards the front. Gross weight of pendant 25.7g.

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
