A set of six Victorian silver mounted interfitting horn beakers of tapering cylindrical form, each with a silver collar and monogram engraved shield shaped panel, London 1879 by Brockwell & Son, height of largest beaker 12cm, height of smallest beaker 7cm.

### Condition Report

32. A good interfitting set of six beakers. All beakers in generally good condition with no cracks or chips. Silver rims a little loose. Minor dents to silver, but otherwise in good order with matching hallmarks. Tallest beaker, height 12cm - generally good condition, silver rim is loose so would need to be secured. Back of the beaker has dried out a bit and is a little rough, but no chips or cracks. Beaker 2, height 11cm - good condition, rim slightly loose, otherwise good. Beaker 3, height 10.3cm - good condition, rim slightly loose, otherwise good. Beaker 4, height 9.5cm - good condition, rim slightly loose, otherwise good. Beaker 5, height 7.8cm - good condition. Beaker 6, height 7cm - good condition, rim slightly loose, otherwise in good order.
