A late 19th century Anglo-Indian hardwood and bone inlaid display cabinet, the architectural pediment above a pair of glazed panel doors and a cupboard, on block feet, height 235cm, width 138cm, depth 53cm.

Condition Report

910. General appearance is ok, however there are numerous small areas of damage throughout, with losses of bone veneer, small chips to edges and corners, and cracks to the back panels, which are currently held together with packaging tape. Some of the spindles on the pediment are damaged and two are missing. There are some areas of cracking and lifting to veneer and some minor worm to the pediment. Where the piece is sectional and can be taken apart there are numerous areas of minor faults to edges and points. Depth of interior shelves 30cm.
