Condition Report

67. Bowl - misshapen rim and a bit worn, otherwise ok. Good clear hallmarks.

Victorian beaker - dents around edge of base, otherwise ok with typical scratches and wear. Minor misshaping to rim. Good clear hallmarks.

Beaker - misshapen rim, a bit thin and tired and numerous dents around base and a few to body. Marks rubbed.
