Condition Report

421. One of the mirror panels is broken and there are substantial chips to the edges of the crossed corners on the frame. Otherwise, lacking strut to reverse and overall minor scuffs and marks. The Japanese cabinet is quite scuffed and bumped with an overall fairly rough surface with uneven polish.
