An Edwardian gold, diamond and white enamelled brooch, designed as a naval crown, the top claw set with the five principal old cushion cut diamonds above smaller old cushion cut and rose cut diamonds, the ship's sails with white enamelled decoration, width 5.3cm, total diamond weight approx 4.0-4.50ct.

Estimate: £2,000 - £2,500

Condition Report

515. The gold work has an attractive colour patina. The diamonds generally slightly draw colour, showing some degree of florescence and most have one or two internal inclusions. One or two insignificant surface marks to the white enamel. The centre of the back has a threaded hole which would have supported an alternative fitting at some stage. Overall an attractive good quality piece. Colour: on average approx K. Clarity: approx SI1-2. Weight 17.3g.

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
